WHAT DOES THE PRECINCT/CITY TEAM DO?

As a member of the SMGOP Precinct/City/City Team, you will be assigned a territory and asked to engage with members of that community -- by walking Precinct/Cities, making phone calls, attending community events, and becoming ambassadors for the Republican Party in your city and local neighborhoods. Informational materials for voters will be provided to you as part of an organized, county-wide GOP outreach and voter registration program. Members of the Precinct/City Team will be honored volunteers of the SMGOP, invited to participate in exclusive trainings and events with elected Republicans and Republican candidates running for office. If you are sick of losing ground in San Mateo County, and want to see more Republicans win in local elections (from local board races up to the President of the United States), this is an opportunity for you to join the team that will help grow the Republican Party in San Mateo County and ensure Republicans are elected in the next election cycle.

WILL I BE PAID TO SERVE ON THE PRECINCT/CITY TEAM?

No, the SMGOP Precinct/City Team is a team of volunteers, devoted to the values of the Republican Party and working together as part of a County-wide organized network to elect Republicans in San Mateo County elections.

DO I HAVE TO BE A REGISTERED REPUBLICAN TO PARTICIPATE?

Yes, we are seeking a team dedicated to the values of the Republican Party, helping the party grow, and ensuring Republican candidates are elected. A natural pre-requisite is a commitment to the party, which is evidenced by your status as a registered Republican voter.

WHAT IF I AM ALREADY A PRECINCT/CITY TEAM MEMBER OR VOLUNTEER WITH A CANDIDATE OR REPUBLICAN CLUB?

You can do both! Membership on the SMGOP Precinct/City Team is an additional opportunity that can complement your work on other GOP/conservative-based campaigns, clubs, and programs. In fact, one of the goals of the SMGOP Precinct/City Team is to help grow the membership in all local Republican/Conservative clubs throughout San Mateo County by engaging voters and specifically inviting them to club meetings. With the aim to unite our Republican grassroots community in a county-wide network of volunteers, we hope that all clubs will encourage their members to participate -- so every club will have at least one representative on the SMGOP Precinct/City Team.

DO I NEED TO HAVE ANY EXPERIENCE TO DO THIS JOB?

No, although we are looking for people with some campaign/Precinct/City level and managerial experience to fill the larger territorial roles (District/City Chairs), there is no experience required to serve as a Precinct/City Captain or any of the other assigned roles. As a member of the SMGOP Precinct/City Team, you will be invited to exclusive Precinct/City Team training events.

HOW MUCH OF A TIME COMMITMENT IS REQUIRED TO SERVE AS PRECINCT/CITY TEAM MEMBER?

How much time are you willing to give to fight for the change we need in California and our country? There are several types of positions that require differing levels of commitment. Specifically, the Precinct/City Team consists of various territorial assignments that need to be filled, including large territories (e.g., Supervisorial District-Wide or City Chairs) that involve a more substantial time commitment, our Precinct/City Chairs (responsible for a Precinct/City area which typically

encompasses several neighborhoods) and requires a modest time commitment, and down to more personalized smaller territories, such as neighborhood tracts or block captains that require less time. For those unable to walk Precinct/Cities, we have a Precinct/City Call Team that you can be a part of instead, for as many hours as you can spare. There is a role for anyone willing to commit some portion of their time to this program. The term for this recruitment will cover the election term or as requested. Although there may be other outreach efforts from time to time, the Precinct/City Team will primarily be engaged in targeted programs to reach voters in relation to each election term. The most significant work and time commitment will thus be required during the two-month period preceding an election (i.e. - the June 2022 primary election and the November 2022 General Election). Precinct/City Team members will have the flexibility to choose when it makes most sense for them to contact and engage voters in their respective assigned territories, so there is no set schedule expected. The harder we work, however, the more impact we will have, so the more time you can commit to your assigned territory, the more successful the team will be.

IS THERE A WAY YOUNGER PEOPLE THAT ARE NOT REGISTERED VOTERS (18 YEARS OR YOUNGER) CAN PARTICIPATE ON THE PRECINCT/CITY TEAM?

Yes! We encourage Precinct/City Team members to get their kids involved as part of the team as appropriate.

WILL I HAVE ANY FUN IF I JOIN THIS TEAM?

Of course! As any good team must do, we will gather to celebrate our victories and recognize team members who have exceptionally performed on the Precinct/City Team. As a member of the Precinct/City Team, you will be invited to exclusive social gatherings with elected Republicans and candidates, including an annual holiday party, Precinct/City team district-wide or city events, and a summer picnic expected to be scheduled on July 4th, 2022. As a recognized HONORED VOLUNTEERS of the SMGOP, we hope you will find your membership and work on the Precinct/City Team to be both rewarding and an honor.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

HOW WILL I KNOW WHAT TERRITORY I HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED? Great questions! We are accepting applications on our website at smgop.org/precinct-team. We will be accepting applications until all positions have been filled. A member of the Precinct/City Team will contact you to confirm your membership on the 2021-2022 Precinct/City Team. Unless assigned to one of the larger territories, you will most likely be assigned to serve in your home Precinct/City.
